



I Love To Read Week

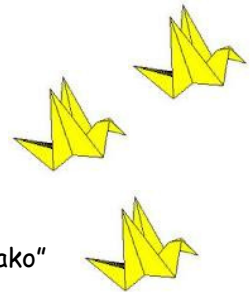
Oct. 17th to Oct. 21st 2011

Geordie Productions will present "A Thousand Paper Cranes: The Story of Sadako" at 1:30 PM in the gym.

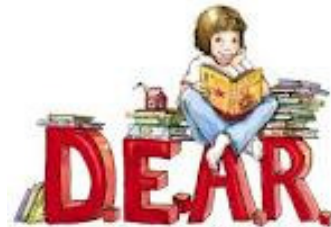
